

Folinic acid

Other names: Rescuvolin, Leucovorin, Calciumfolinaat, Ledervorin calcium, Folikabi

What is it and how does it work?

A vitamin that is given to reduce the toxicity of high doses of methotrexate.

What does it look like and how is it given?

- A tablet or drink that is taken by mouth (oral).
- A clear liquid that is administered as a bolus injection into a vein (intravenous).
